Dear Anita

You'll have seen my complaint to the Information Regulator yesterday, copied to you, about the LPC's illegal and unconstitutional refusal to respond to my PAIA request made in January, on the ridiculous and unlawful basis – not permitted by PAIA as a ground for refusing or obstructing a record request – that it's 'premature' in the LPC's irrelevant opinion. (The complaint is also accessible online at bit.ly/44d2dy7.)

Any intelligent and competent lawyer employed or briefed by the LPC who's asked to assess my complaint will advise you that the LPC really needs to respond to my request without further unlawful delay and to quit talking this 'premature' nonsense, obviously thought up by a legally unqualified person without a clue as to how PAIA works.

If, as properly legally advised, the LPC now belatedly respects my fundamental right to information guaranteed by section 32 of the Constitution, and responds to my PAIA request at last, it will save the Information Regulator the hassle of having to get involved in this unnecessary, time-wasting mess, and it will spare the LPC the embarrassment and disgrace of being reported to the National Assembly as a Constitution-flouting PAIA delinquent in the Information Regulator's annual report under section 84 of PAIA.

Arising from some information given to me in Nadira's last email to me in May, I'm amending my PAIA request to add four further record specifications.

This supplementary records request, comprising new items 12-15, is attached.

Kindly ensure that these further record requests are also duly responded to by the LPC's information officer or duly delegated deputy information officer, either by delivery of the records specified or an affidavit certifying that they don't exist.

As I said in my complaint, I'm not particularly bothered about the LPC's failure to comply with the time limits that PAIA sets for the LPC's now very overdue response to my request: I just want the documents I've specified or sworn certification of any that don't exist.

Can we now get on with it please?
