But you do understand, I hope, that it doesn't detract from the LPC's constitutional and legal obligation to duly respond to my now very long outstanding PAIA request, as amended a few minutes ago.

I absolutely want copies of the records I've duly requested or sworn certification of any that don't exist.

This is irrespective of what the Investigating Committee is currently up to, and what it eventually decides to do with LASA's rotten complaint, i.e. its attempt to murder me professionally for duly complaining (the JCC has agreed) of Mlambo JP's repeated criminal mendacity in lying to the National Assembly, to the Justice Minister, and to the Labour Court in his false reports and false affidavits to mislead and deceive them. An extremely serious matter.

If Anita would just get cracking, and assure me she's now onto it, I can ask the Information Regulator to pend its case file on the basis that the matter is finally in hand, so there's no need to send its investigators to come knocking at the LPC's KZN office, looking into why the LPC is violating its constitutional information transparency obligations by withholding duly requested documents from me, and why in our open democracy it's so strangely reluctant to open its books to me as PAIA requires.
